## **ABOUT THE MES**

In just two years of part-time study, ,educational professionals can complete a Master of Education in Educational Studies (MES), build knowledge in an area of education that is of particular interest to them, and enhance their ability to apply evidence-based practices to support educational improvement.

The MES facilitates pursuing graduate studies without taking time off work. It is blended delivery:

- four core courses are taken during two summer residencies in the first three weeks of July (Year 1 and Year 2)
- four core courses are taken online (one in the fall and one in the winter of Year 1 and Year 2)
- two graduate-level, approved electives are taken at the student's discretion (typically in the spring of Year 1 and Year 2)

To optimize the learning experience, the program is also cohort-based: students take their core courses in sequence, integrating their areas of professional interest into their studies, and working towards a research assignment that documents their investigation and its implications for professional practice. ## THE MES & IB PARTNERSHIP

The University of Alberta is one of only four Canadian universities that is IB accredited to offer programs of graduate-level study leading to an IB Advanced Certificate in Teaching and Learning Research and one of only two Canadian universities that is IB accredited to offer graduate-level study leading to an IB Advanced Certificate in Leadership Research.
